MAYOR Vote for not more than 1	<p align="center">GARDEN CITY STREET IMPROVEMENT BOND PROPOSAL</p> <p>Shall the City of Garden City, County of Wayne, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds, in one or more series, payable in not to exceed fifteen (15) years from the date of issuance of each series, for the purpose of paying the cost to improve, replace, resurface, and reconstruct streets in the City, including sidewalk improvements, drainage improvements, and water and sewer improvements, together with necessary rights-of-way, appurtenances and attachments thereto?</p> <p>The estimated millage to be levied in 2018 is 0.7495 mills (\$0.7495 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 6.2266 mills (\$6.2266 per \$1,000 of taxable value).</p> <p align="right">YES <input type="radio"/></p> <p align="right">NO <input type="radio"/></p>

Patricia McKarge <input type="radio"/>	<p align="center">GARDEN CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL</p> <p>This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy.</p> <p>Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 19.8320 mills (\$19.8320 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Garden City Public Schools, Wayne County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2019 to 2023, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2019 is approximately \$2,944,272 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2018 tax levy)?</p> <p align="right">YES <input type="radio"/></p> <p align="right">NO <input type="radio"/></p>
