

# CITIZENS ACADEMY



## What is it?

The Garden City Police Department's Citizen Academy is designed to give the public a working knowledge of the police department. It is a 10-week course with each week covering different areas of the department.

## When is it?

The academy will begin on January 17th, 2023. Classes will continue to meet every Tuesday from 06:30pm to 08:30pm until the conclusion of the course.

## Who is eligible?

The minimum age is 21. Applications may either live in the city or have some affiliation with the city (example: church, business owner, etc.)

## OUR PRUPOSE

The Citizens Academy offers various courses of instruction with allows attendees to have a better understanding of how their police department functions. Through this educational process, you will be exposed to all aspects of policing which included training, departmental policies, legal aspects, and decision making.

## INSTRUCTION

Many diverse topics will be covered such as patrol duties, drunk driving enforcement, traffic enforcement, community resource bureau, investigations, special assignments, and more. Instruction will include a segment on firearms, defensive tactics, and use of force decision making.

Applications can be obtained through the City of Garden City website or can be picked up in person at the front desk! The academy will be limited to 12 attendees.
